

How to GROW AN AVOCADO TREE FROM SEED

STEP 1



Remove & clean pit

STEP 2



Pierce with four toothpicks and place avocado seed half submerged in a glass of water

STEP 3



STEP 4

When the stem is 6-7 inches long, cut it back to about 3 inches, this will encourage new growth.



STEP 5

When it hits 6-7 inches again, pot it up in a rich humus soil in an 8-10 inch diameter pot, leaving the top half of the seed exposed. Place on a sunny windowsill.



STEP 6



Water & watch it grow

CARING FOR YOUR AVOCADO TREE

When the stem reaches 12 inches tall, pinch out the top two sets of leaves to encourage the plant to grow.



Give it frequent waterings with an occasional deep soak. The soil should always be moist, but not saturated.

Pests: Check your plant every 4-5 days, re-clean and spray when necessary.



If you live anywhere where it gets cooler than 45° F, you'll need to bring the baby avocado tree back indoors in the fall/winter, before the temperature drops.
